TEC and CTCN to undertake further work relating to:

- Technology RD&D
- The development and enhancement of endogenous capacities and technologies

Further work to support enhanced action prior to 2020

- TEC and CTCN to undertake activities relating to:
 - Engage in the TEMs
 - To provide regular update during the TEMs on progress made
 - To include information on their activities under this process in their joint annual report to the COP
- TEC to be consulted on the organization of the TEM regarding the focused topics of the TEMs (1/CP.21, paragraph 111 a)

• TEC and CTCN to report to the CMA on their activities to support the implementation of the PA (decision 1/CP.21, paragraph 68)
