Letter from the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage (WIM ExCom)

In 2015, the Chair and Vice-Chair of the TEC received a letter from the Co-Chairs of the WIM ExCom, which invited the TEC:

- •To <u>consider making efforts to reduce and avert loss and damage</u> among particularly vulnerable developing countries, vulnerable populations and the ecosystems that they depend on, as the TEC undertakes its work;
- •To share the outcomes with the WIM ExCom.

- ☐ The TEC requested the task force on emerging and cross-cutting issues to undertake further work on this matter by:
 - Identifying TEC outputs that may be relevant to this collaboration;
 - Examining further the information provided by the WIM ExCom and any relevant information resulting from the outcomes of the Marrakech conference related to loss and damage;
 - Preparing recommendations for entry points for collaboration with the WIM ExCom.

The task force has undertaken the inter-sessional work above.
