- ❖ The TEC regularly participated in previous TEM-Ms presenting its work related to mitigation on the TEP
- ❖ TEC 13 recommended potential topics for the organization of future TEMs

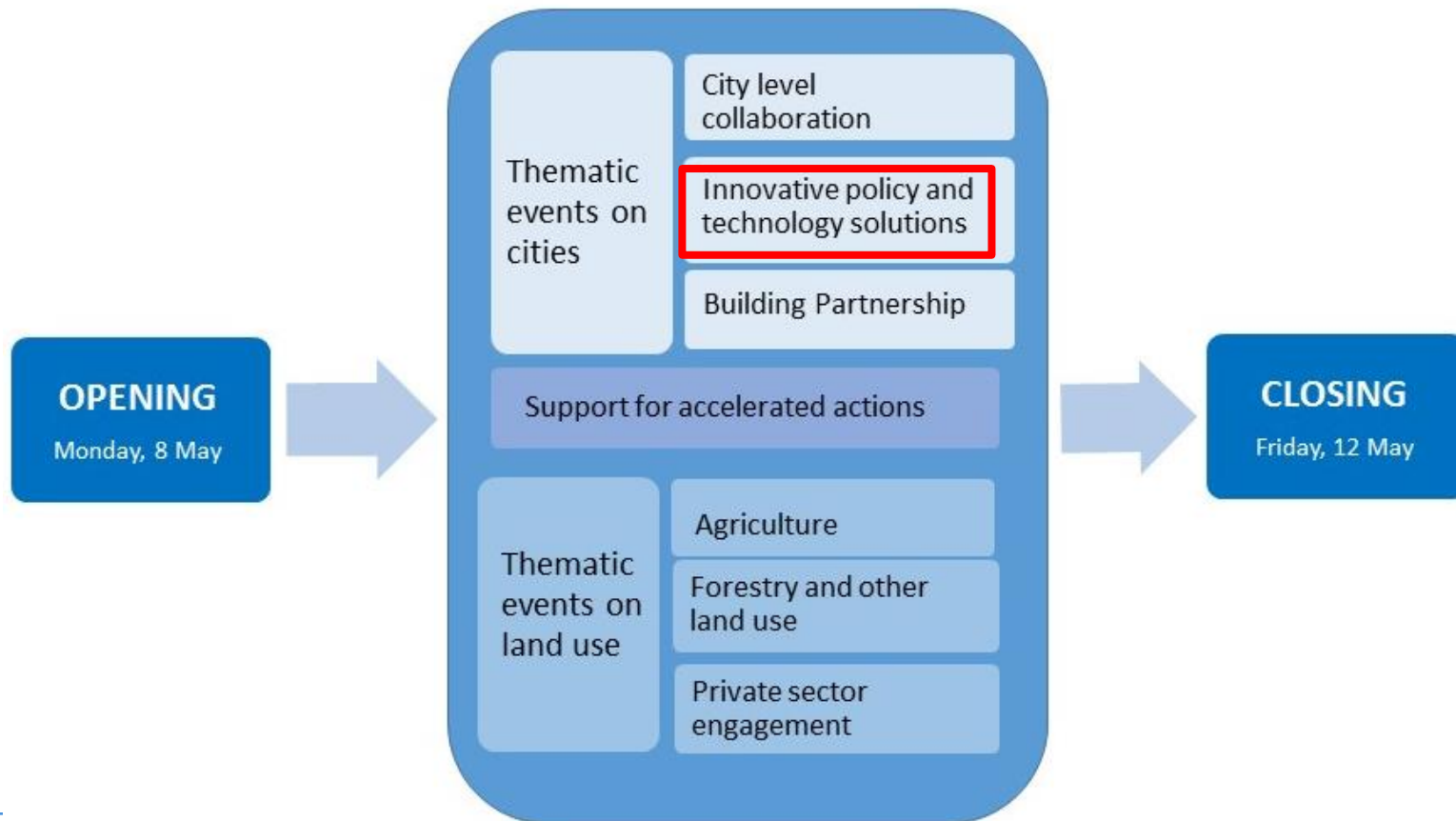
### TEM-M in 2017:
